"Why are you so rebellious? It will be late if something really happens." said Victoria worriedly.



"Why aren't you worried at all? You will get stabbed if you lose!" Victoria








was going nuts.








Wyatt nodded. "I will definitely be fair, and I won't distort the facts for the sake of Connor. Who wants to cut his stone first?"
